Department: Botany

Department of Botany, Deshbandhu College organized a 'One Week Summer Training Programme in Plant Systematics' in collaboration with ICAR-NBPGR Pusa, New Delhi and BGIR, Noida from 31 May, 2019 to 06 June, 2019. Dr. Roshni Rajamohan was the coordinator of the programme. More than 25 participants including, under graduate students, post graduate students and research scholars from University of Delhi participated in the programme. The key topics of the programme were; Describing a New Species, Key Preparation, Field Activities, Herbarium Techniques, Molecular Markers in Plant Systematics, Tree Costruction using Mesquite, Molecular Systematics, Chemotaxonomy, DNA Barcoding, etc. Students thoroughly enjoyed, learned various aspects of plant taxonomy and also come to know about the scope and future in plant taxonomy. The programme ended by organizing a valedictory function on 06 June, 2019. Prof. Arun Kumar Pandey (Vice Chancellor, Mansarovar Global University, Bhopal, M.P.) was the chief guest on the occasion. Prof. Pandey briefed us about the challenges, scope and future in plant systematics and also talked about the relevance of the programme in current scenario. Tree plantation in Botanical garden was also done on the occasion by Prof Pandey along with Dr. Rajiv Aggarwal, Principal Deshbandhu College. The programme was ended with the distribution of certificates to the participants by the chief guest.

Botanical Excursion to Chopta, Uttarakhand

Department of Botany, Deshbandhu College organized a Botanical excursion to Chopta, Uttarakhand during 12 -16 September, 2019. Students of B. Sc. (Hons) Botany and B. Sc. (Prog) Life Sciences along with some faculty members and Lab-staff participated in the excursion. On the way to Chopta we visited HNB Garhwal Central University, Srinagar. Where, the students were addressed by Prof. B.P. Chamola and other scientists, visited herbal garden and other fields as well. By evening, after a very long and tiring but enjoyable journey we reached Chopta. Next day morning we moved to our next destination, Tung Nath temple (situated at elevation of 4000m asl) by tracking through a 5 km mountainous track. The track was beautiful lush green mountainous slop covered with trees and very rich in flora. Students observed, learned and discussed about the flora including various species of Fungi, Bryophytes, Gymnosperms and Angiosperms. They also learned to identify, collect and preserve different specimens of these groups. By 6 PM we came back to our tent-houses located on open green field, surrounded by thick forest. The cool healthy fresh air, clear blue sky and attractive surroundings gave a divine peace and calmness to mind and made us fresh. Next morning after having breakfast we packed up and boarded the buses for back journey to Delhi. On the way we also visited Devprayag and Rishikesh. Altogether, the visit was an amalgamation of fun, education and an inspiration for all.

Dragonfly Campus Count-2019

Bombay Natural History Society's Conservation Education Centre (BNHS-CEC)- Delhi, as a part of the Delhi Dragonfly month-2019 celebration, selected Deshbandhu College campus as one of the survey site for the Delhi dragonfly count. On 13th September, 2019, Dr. Ishteyak Ahemad, Education officer (BNHS-CEC) at Asola Bhatti Wildlife Sanctuary, Delhi along with Department of Botany, Deshbandhu College conducted Dragonfly count/survey in our college campus. During the event, Dr. Ahemad presented an informative documentary and delivered a talk; highlighting the importance and conservation of Dragonflies, followed by discussion. More than 80 students and teachers from various Departments participated in the event. The session was followed by counting/survey of Dragonflies in Deshbandhu College campus. During the survey it was found that Deshbandhu College campus harbours a good number of Dragonflies, among the other college campuses of Delhi University, indicating relatively healthy flora/environment of our college campus. The take home message of the talk was the importance and significance of Dragonflies in biological control of mosquito population.

Butterfly Count in Deshbandhu College Campus (2019)

As a part of the Butterfly Census program under the Bombay Natural History Society Conservation Education Centre (BNHS-CEC)- Delhi, Deshbandhu College campus was selected as one of the survey site for the Delhi Butterfly Census. On 16th September, 2019 students of B.Sc. (Hons) Botany and Life Sciences along with faculty members conducted butterfly survey in Deshbandhu College campus under the keen guidance of Dr. Ishtiyak Ahmad, Education Officer, BNHS, CEC-Delhi. Before the survey, Dr. Ahemad presented an informative documentary about the butterflies and thereafter delivered a talk; highlighting the key features, importance, threats and conservation needs of butterflies. The talk was well appreciated by all and discussed in length. More than 100 students and teachers from various Departments participated in the event. During the butterfly census, a good number of butterflies were recorded mainly on *Ixora*, Aak (*Calotropis*), *Bryophyllum*, *Cassia fistula* (Amaltas), *Aeglemarmelos* (Bael), *Murraya koenigii* (Curry-leaf plant), Lemon tree, Neem etc. and the number of butterflies recorded was 25% higher than the last years survey. It was observed that Deshbandhu College campus harbours a good number of butterflies among the other college campuses of Delhi University, indicating a reasonably good flora/environment of our college campus. Students were inspired to grow more such plants in the campus and near-by areas to attract more and more of butterflies.

Inaugural function of Botanical Society

The botanical society of Deshbandu College organized its Inaugral function on 18th September, 2019. This event is held every year as a way of announcing the commencement of the new session of the society. The event began with the lighting of the lamp accompanied by the singing of Saraswati Vandana by fellow students. Professor M.V. Rajam (Department of Genetics, University of Delhi, South Campus) was the chief guest on the occasion. Dr. Anju Chhibbar, advisor Botanical society along with Dr. Rajender Kumar (Teacher-in-Charge) and Dr. Dharmendra K. Mallick felicitated the chief guest. Prof. Rajam gave a talk on—"*Transgenic and RNA silencing based strategies* for crop protection against pathogens and insect pests" wherein he talked about how RNA interference is a potent method using only a

Department: Chemistry

Chemical Society of Department of Chemistry "Resonance" under the aegis of DBT star College scheme has organized an inaugural function on 27th September 2019. In this Programme Professor S. M. S. Chauhan has delivered an invited lecture on on the topic of "Pigments of Life". Professor S. M. S. Chauhan, is an Emeritus Professor from Department of Chemistry, University of Delhi. During his talk Professor Chauhan have elaborated the basic chemistry involved in the pigments of life. He discussed about the biosynthesis of tetrapyrolic compounds including porphyrins, metalloporphyrins etc. followed by their importance in the structure of Chlorophyll. Radical cation of diamagnetic Mg and Zn chlorophyll indicates the generation of radical cation at prosthetic group of Mg Chlorophyll. Degradation of chlorophyll and protoporphyrin IX in different condition have also been discussed. The nitration of selected unmetallated and metallated porphyrin are also discussed during the talk. The overall session was quite interactive and enthusiastic. The talk of the speaker was followed by the various intercollege events for the undergraduate students including poster making, Chem Charades and talent hunt competition (criss-cross, crossword, creative writing). All the event/ competitions of resonance were evaluated by jury members consisting of Convener (Dr. Deo Nandan Kumar), Co-convener (Dr. Mahesh Chandra), co-ordinators and co-coordinators of the respective event. The prize winning creative writing proposals were further announced to be added in the upcoming departmental magazine "Deshrasayan". All the competitions and events held during Resonance 2019 were based to enhance the scientific interaction, talent and skills of the participating students.

Department of Chemistry has organized an International seminar on the topic of "Sovereignty of Nanotechnology in environmental sustainability". Professor Ajay Mishra, from (Nanotechnology and water sustainability research unit, college of engineering, science and technology), University of South Africa, Johannesburg was the chief guest of this event. His area of interest includes Nanoscience/Nanotechnology, Materials Science; Polymers, Composite/Nanocomposites and water research.

Professor Mishra addressed the current and emerging issues relating to water quality and water scarcity in his talk "Sovereignty of Nanotechnology in environmental sustainability. He has focused on the development of nanotechnology techniques including enhanced membrane materials and adsorbents for the water treatment/ purification and desalination. He enlightened the audience about the synthesis of multifunctional nano-materials, nano-composites, biopolymer and/or petrochemical based biodegradable polymers, polymers based materials/composites, smart materials, CNT and graphene based composite materials and water research He has discussed about the development of novel nanomaterials as adsorbents, or the removal of metal ions for water purification and understanding the fate of these engineered nanoparticles in the environment. Synthesis, characterization and mechanism of adsorption for Cr (VI) was elaborated using Chitosan modified clay nanocomposites. Being, a natural, widely abundant in nature, having low cost and high adsorption and cation exchange capacity clay can be used as an efficient adsorbate for the removal of metal ions from contaminated water. He has also discussed about the synthetic methodology and application of polypyrole—Glycerine iron oxide nanocomposites for water remediation and removal of metal ions. He also enlightened the students by discussing about the Ankon water supply treatment process. In the conclusion, the research data shown ensure that polluted water is treated to acceptable levels suitable for its purpose, for example, drinking or any non-potable use, such as industrial, agricultural or groundwater discharge. During his talk he encouraged the student to understand the concept of chemistry involved water treatment and remediation process.

Department of Chemistry has given admission to 32 students in B. Sc. (H) Chemistry and 93 students to B. Sc. Program (Industrial Chemistry) during the session of 2019-2020.

Department: Physics

Physics Department is mandated to nurture high standards of education to our undergraduate students of Honours and Programme. The department has highly experienced and research oriented faculty members who constantly engage in raising the academic standards of the department to accomplish this mandate. Due to the concerted efforts of its faculty members and non-teaching staff the department has been able to establish well equipped Physics experiment Labs such as Solid State Physics Lab, Electronics Lab, Computational Techniques Lab, Numerical Simulation Lab, Communications Lab, Thermal lab, Optics, Opto-electronics and Waves Lab, Electricity and Magnetism Lab and Mechanics lab. The department has developed two new practical labs i.e. Advanced Optics Lab including interferometry and spectrophotometry and Nanomaterials Fabrication and Analysis lab in the current session. In order to give a fillip to skill based education the department has also established an Instrumentation Lab where the undergraduate students will be encouraged to tinker with different undergraduate concepts of **Physics** fabricate basic instrumentation for the curriculum. Thedepartment faculty is taking initiative stofabricate low cost equipments in the lab itself. Two of the experimental set-ups that have been put in place are (a) to determine g value of a freely falling body by digital timing technique and (b) polarization by diffraction method.

Thedepartmenthasalsostartedanambitiousbasicresearchprogrammeaimedatdevelopinga research bent of mind amongst undergraduate studentsunder the aegis of DBT-STAR College Scheme in which the department is one of the five participating departments. Kumar, JNU and Dr. Balaji Birajdar, JNU had delivered lectures entitled "Magnetic Nanostructures for microwave/mm-wave electronics enabling 5G technology and beyond" and "Nanoscale characterization using electron microscopy" respectively. Students got a chance to understand nanoscale characterization techniques such as Scanning Electron Microscopy (SEM) and Transmission Electron Microscopy (TEM). The lectures elaborated about the need for these techniques at nanoscale.

Department the **DST-INSPIRE** Internship **Program** Physics was also partner department in heldfromthe17thDecember2019to21stDecember,2019wherechildrenfrommorethan200 schools participated and the department set up experiments in digital electronics on designing of voting machine. - Biodiversity is the essence of life, therefore, the Department of Zoology this year started a Biodiversity Club to ignite the young minds and to deepen their knowledge of biodiversity and its conservation. This club was initiated by Dr. Varsha Baweja and the student president Mr. Prithwik Bhowmik of B.Sc. Hons IIIrd year. Following activities were organized in the academic year (2019-2020):
- 1. Under the aegis of DBT Star College a nature walk was organized to explore and document the insect biodiversity of Deshbandhu College Campus on September 28, 2019. 60 students along with mentors Dr Kamal Kumar Gupta (Co-ordinator), Dr Sunil Kayesth, Dr Moses Rinchui, Mr Mohd Shazad, Dr Gouri Nandy, Dr Gajendra Singh and Mr Akshay Dwivedi participated in the programme. The college campus was divided into 6 zones depending on the density of vegetation cover of the area. More than 100 different types of insects belonging to order Thysanura, Odonata, Orthoptera, Dermaptra, Embioptera, Dictyoptera, Isoptera, Thysanoptera, Lepidoptera, Diptera and Hymenoptera, Coleoptera were observed. The most commonly observed insects were butterflies, moths, bees, wasps, different types of flies and beetles. The insects were captured in camera.
- 2. A nature walk to Okhla Bird Sanctuary intending to observe and assess, both the flora and the fauna of the sanctuary, with special emphasis on the avian population was organized on January 23, 2020 under the guidance of Dr Varsha Baweja and alumnus of the department and biodiversity extraordinaire Akshay Dwivedi. 50 students along with teachers Dr Kiran Bala, Dr Gouri Nandi, Dr Sushma Sharma and Dr Gajendra Singh participated in this one day long visit. Around 60 birds belonging to various families were observed. To name a few there were Brown headed barbet, Pied bushchat, Indian grey hornbill, Purple swamphen, Great cormorant, White breasted Kingfisher, Red Whiskered bulbul, Black-headed Gull, Painted stork, Spot-billed duck, Little Grebe, Common Moorhen, Common Chifchaf, Purple heron, Great white pelican. In hindsight, this excursion was as fruitful as they come because the students gained knowledge of a plethora of birds as well as the ecology of that region.

Every dark cloud has a silver lining and therefore, there will be a refreshing revival in the lives of the beneficiaries and so we ignited a lamp in profound darkness by starting Project Amartya. Project AMARTYA focuses on the all-round development and upliftment of women who are visually impaired and acid attack survivors, to immortalise their fighting spirit.

A canteen committee was constituted in the month of May, 2018; and following were the members.

Since 2107, Mr. Ashok was running the canteen. As the committee received repeated complaints and on-site verification, Mr. Ashok was asked to vacate the canteen and committee decided to open a new tender.

Retendering of the canteen was done on 9-8-2018, and 12 company/ firm had applied for the canteen. After verification of the technical specification, nine were shortlisted and were screened by onsite evaluation on the basis of taste, oil quality, waste disposal, cooking cleaning practices, infra-structure, staff services, No. of workers, worker uniform, safety, maintenance, item brands etc.

After On-site verification and screening the documents, four were called for the interview and Saint Marry Caterer was selected for running the canteen.

A letter to Mr. Ashok, who was running the canteen earlier was given on 9-10-18 and canteen was given to Mr. Razi, Saint Marry Caterer, for some civil work to be done for the smooth running of the canteen. After renovation and civil work done, he started the canteen from the month of November 1, 2018.

Mr. Razi operated the canteen for approximately one year but his quality and quantity was compromised after some times. Also, on the basis of repeated complaints, and his inability to fulfill college terms and condition, Mr. Razi was asked to vacate the canteen till the new allotment of tender. The committee opened a new tender for the canteen with some strict terms and conditions. On 18-06-2019 meeting, six tenders were opened by the committee and after verification of technical bids all were called for the interview. In the same meeting, the committee also recommended the opening of a coffee house in the campus. A tender for the Coffee house was also floated. After complete screening of the canteen and coffee house bids, a comparative statement was formed, in which, Diya Enterprises and Jay caterers were the firms who were fulfilled all the terms and conditions. On the basis of technical bids, financial bids and interview, the committee awarded Diya Enterprises for the Coffee house and Jay Caterer for the canteen to run in the college campus for three and one year subjected to the annual satisfaction of the canteen committee respectively. Both, the Diya Enterprises and Jay Caterer are successfully running the coffee house and canteen. Canteen Committee on the basis of regular on-site evaluation, feedback from students, teachers, and Non-teaching members recommended the extension of the tenure till 2020.

Various meetings of the Committee were held during this academic session with the Principal and following steps were initiated and completed during this tenure with the cooperation of the committee members and gardeners of the college

- 1. Purchase of Petrol-operated Lawn Mower
- 2. Purchase of seasonal plant saplings
- 3. Purchase of pots for plants
- 4. Purchase and maintenance of garden equipment/items
- 5. On request, saplings and flowering potted plants for decoration for various functions held in the college was provided from time to time.
- 6. Plantation of 300 saplings was taken up within the campus in collaboration with NSS unit and NGO- Integrated Volunteers Network (IVN), under the Green College Project.

- 7. All the lawns in the college were bordered with hedge plants.
- 8. Pavement area was opened and grill work done bordering the pavement which connects Science block to Cafeteria.
- 9. Abandoned grills lying the central lawns were removed and relocated and the gardens were beautified with seasonal flowering plants.
- 10. New pipeline was established for the front lawn near gate.
- 11. The new garden areas created in front of New Science block and cafeteria were activated by supplementing soil and flowering plants were established.
- 12. The garden areas in front of Canteen and Porta cabin were activated by supplementing manured soil and flowering plants.
- 13. Tiling of the surface of the water harvesting underground tank was initiated and completed.
- 14. Meetings with experts were held to develop the garden near main gate. Manured soil was procured and filled in this garden area which was ruined during construction work and now, is made ready for development of lawn.
- 15. Pruning of all overgrown trees/ plants and mowing of lawns were done timely to maintain all the garden areas including the Botanical Garden.

PROSPECTUS COMMITTEE

Prospectus Committee successfully completed all the prospectus related work on time for the academic session 2019-20. Following is the brief report

- Quotation were invited by college for printing of Prospectus. The printer was selected by Purchase Committee based on lowest price quotation.
- System was installed by Printer in College and all the work was done in College under the supervision of Prospectus Committee.
- Prospectus Committee met time to time to make prospectus more informative and student oriented.
- To show our gratitude, a photograph and brief introduction of Lala Deshbandhu Gupta was given in the beginning.
- All the admission related necessary information was included both in Hindi and English language to meet the needs of all students. The main ordinances of University of Delhi were also given bilingually as in previous academic session.
- Subject combinations for BA (Prog) and seat distribution for various courses was incorporated as received from College office.
- Department in-charges were requested to send their updated information and course structure. All the information was appropriately incorporated in prospectus as received.
- There were dedicated pages for each department for the updated information and course structure of Honors Courses. The Course structure of Programme Courses was given separately as was in previous year Prospectus. A table of Course structure of BA (Prog) was included to make it easy to understand for students.
- A brief about the facility and resources of Deshbandhu College was given with details of library facility. Students Guide was updated highlighting the Attendance Rules and Internal Assessment Scheme to make students aware of academic requirement. NCC, NSS and other cultural activities were included under the head "Life at Deshbandhu"
- A page comprised of Notable Alumni of Deshbandhu College was added. More Alumni may be added in forthcoming prospectus.
- Admission related FAQ were incorporated. Further University help desk contact was included along with important helpline numbers.
- A comprehensive proof reading and corrections was done by committee members to minimize the errors to maximum extent possible.
- All the admission related forms of UG and PG were updated and printed
- A disclaimer was added stating that the information given in the prospectus informative and should not be used for legal purposes.
- Printer worked satisfactorily and delivered the order on time. The bill submitted by printer was checked and approved for payment by Prospectus Committee.

All the Committee members, Dr. Savita Singh, Dr. Aparna Shekhar, Dr. Pratibha Kumari, Dr. Rakesh K. Singh and Dr. Manish Kumar worked hard and gave their precious time during summer vacation to accomplish the task. Dr. Varsha Singh guided us whenever required. Without team work the timely completion of work was impossible.

Dr. Parul Singh Convener Prospectus Committee 2019-20 The Students' Union Advisory Committee worked closely with the students' union under the leadership of "Dr. Sangita Singh" to ensure a holistic student development which was inclusive and collaborative in nature. Students worked on multi-dimensional activities. The Student Union was encouraged to innovate and explore new areas. The student union activities started with the oath taking ceremony which happened in the month of October. As a social responsibility initiative, a Clothes Donation Drive organised by the union in association with an NGO, "PEHLI AASHA" in the month of January 2020. Another important event "DESH KI BAAT" was organized by Student Union to spread awareness among youth in the nation building. Similarly, the Student Union organized a candle march in Kalkaji area to pay tribute to Dr. Priyanka Reddy, the Hyderabad rape victim in the month of December. The union for the benefit of girl students worked for the installation of sanitary pad vending machine in GCR and other girl's washroom of college campus along with incinerator. The union worked towards improving sitting arrangement in GCR, and better drinking water availability in the canteen. To improve college brand the union printed T-shirts and Hoodies as "Deshbandhu College". To encourage girl's participation in sports, the union helped in forming Volleyball and Cricket teams in the college. In the annual cultural event "SABRANG 2k20" of the college two well-known stars performed and other cultural activities were organized successfully in the month of March. The union members proactively addressed the issues brought to their attention by the students and dealt with them to the best of their abilities and satisfaction of the students.

WEBSITE COMMITTEE

The website committee was constituted in year 2017 to work on website design that is user friendly and an appropriate reflection of college activities besides providing important information to stakeholders. The website committee carries out updates of the website as well as coordinates with the vendor for the website maintenance.

For effective coordination with various departments/committees the website committee regularly takes input of TICs and other faculty members of all the departments in the college. Recently the committee facilitated design and development of google sites for individual departments to be linked and embedded in the main website.

There is a detailed access to Academics section including department wise sections. The CVs of all the faculty members were updated. New heads for AQAR, NIFR (National Institutional Ranking Framework) have been incorporated. A new link for Examinations directing to Delhi University portal is functional under Academics now.

The Research section was restructured and updated and has been augmented with new head for Abstracts & Articles and Books.

The Library section which consists of links to Delhi University Library System and DELNET was restructured and updated. College magazine Desh was also added in there as well as the Library rules made up to date. Webopac, which is the Online Public Access Catalogue which allows users avail the services of the library using Internet was made functions after the library software was updated. Page under the head 'Electronic Resources in Public Domain' was reviewed and scaled up.

Students section has been enhanced with various new heads, E-resources, Time table being the most significant. Time tables of all the courses are available in the Time table page of the Student section.

For the OBE exam a google site was designed and maintained by the website committee for having all OBE related information segregated and available at one click. IQAC and ICC sections were created.

Other updates include but not limited to Notices for faculty and students and events, IQAC page, NCC/NSS/Sports. Video and photograph gallery is regularly updated as well as 'Discover More' section was redesigned.

In the last semester when online teaching started website committee maintained and updated the e-resources page of all the departments. Regular posting of lecture notes and other reading materials was made available to the students at the e-resources page.
