



LALA DESHBANDHU GUPTA (14 June 1901 – 21 November 1951)

Born as Rati Ram Gupta in 1901 in Panipat, he was given the title "Deshbandhu", or friend of the nation, by Swami Shraddhanand and Mahatma Gandhi. Popularly known as Lala Deshbandhu Gupta, he was a veteran freedom fighter, legislator and journalist.

He contributed in Lala Lajpat Rai's newspaper "VandeMataram" as an editor, thus beginning his life-long association with journalism. As both a journalist and Constituent Assembly member, he is known to have staunchly supported freedom of the Press in India and argued for assembly status for the National Capital Territory of Delhi. He played an important role in controlling communal tensions and maintaining harmony during partition in Delhi. Unfortunately, he died in a plane crash on 21st November,1951 while on his way to Calcutta (Now Kolkata).

His contribution to the country as a distinguished legislator, reputed journalist and a revolutionary freedom fighter is memorialized in the name of the college that we are all proud to be a part of.

INTRODUCTION

Deshbandhu College is a fully maintained constituent college of Delhi University, with the distinction of being the oldest and the largest co-educational institution in South Delhi. The College was established in 1952 by the Ministry of Rehabilitation, in the memory of Lala Deshbandhu Gupta, a veteran freedom fighter and Member of Parliament. From its humble beginning as a Prep college for Arts and Sciences, it has expanded its scope to offer eighteen undergraduate and seven post-graduate courses in various disciplines, catering to over 5000 students every year.

Guided by our motto "Karmanyevadhikaraste", the college continues to grow in size and stature, securing All India rank 60 under Colleges Category in NIRF 2021. It secured All India rank 44 in Sciences, rank 54 in Commerce and rank 81 in Arts category and rank 6 in the "Best Placement Record" in the India Today 2021 rankings. The college has been awarded "DBT-Star College Scheme" by the Department of Biotechnology, under which the I-4 Centre (Student Research Centre) was recently established in the college for interdisciplinary research. The College embodies a strong research profile with its faculty having published more than 180 research papers in SCI/SCOPUS/UGC CARE indexed international and national refereed journals and received generous research grants, in the previous year. The College Library, one of the largest in Delhi University, was ranked the best College Library in the University in 2020 in a study published in DESIDOC Journal of Library & Information Technology, DRDO.

Nestled in a sprawling campus with more than sixty percent green cover, the College houses over 35 species of flora and fauna. It also has beautiful gardens, playgrounds, a parade ground and a rich Botanical Garden. The campus is dotted with administrative block and academic blocks, an air-conditioned auditorium with a seating capacity of 200, well equipped laboratories, students' common rooms, gymnasium, canteen, photocopy shop, medical room, banking facility, seminar hall and spacious smart classrooms. These facilities provide the perfect eco system for knowledge creation and dissemination. The College is in the process of turning into a Green Campus with initiatives like solar panels with an installed capacity of 72 kw, switching to PNG, a greener fuel, in our laboratories, rainwater harvesting system, energy efficient lighting with 80% LED lighting and 5 STAR and VRF rating airconditioning systems and has also created an integrated composting facility for producing organic manure. The college premises is 100% compliant as per the norms laid down for making it accessible to differently-abled persons.



C. Other Notable Works

- I. Steps towards environmental conservation
- Advanced Integrated Composting Facility (DBC-AICF): It can perform different types of composting like cold composting, hot composting and vermi composting and mainly focuses on organic waste (fresh organic waste primarily coming from kitchens, restaurants, parks and lawns) including paper, packaging materials etc. and can be processed efficiently in a decentralized manner.
- **Solar Power**: Paying of electricity bill is a noticeable burden for any institution or organization. A great initiative taken by the college in installation of a solar panel, or photo-voltaic module which is an assembly of photo-voltaic cells mounted in a framework. College in collaboration with the Indraprastha Power Generation Company Limited (IPGCL) has installed Rooftop Solar PV System with the model area (7236 Sqr. mtr.) with capacity to produce a 72.36 KW.
- **Bird Housing**: The College has installed more than 40 bird houses and many more bird feeding points to increase the College's bird diversity and start Ornithology as a new area of study.
- Rainwater Harvesting Plant (RHP): The rainwater harvesting system has been installed in campus to use the locally available rainwater to meet water necessities. It is a pioneering practice utilized to harvest rainwater from roofs and to be stored in tank for later use for gardening, crop irrigation, laundry, and flushing toilets. It has an ample number of exciting benefits like backup source of water, ecological benefits and reduces soil erosion.
- **Green Campus and Green Buildings**: The newly developed Green belt of the College uses the concept of rainwater harvesting and it has been designed such that the lower layer of the green belt soil is consisting of fragile material while the upper or top layer of the soil is consisting of clay.
- **Eco Club:** In a drive for the green campus by the Eco Club of the college, 3.5 acres of landscape area has been developed in the backyard with over 500 new plants and grasslands enabling maximum biodiversity and bio-conservation.
- **Sedimentary Rock:** A classic sedimentary rock believed to be 100 million years old has been found during the dig and set for display in the campus itself to highlight the environmental heritage of the institute. The rock sample was examined by Department of Geology, University of Delhi.

II. Incentivising Research and Innovation

• i-4 Center:

Under the patronage of the DBT-STAR College scheme and generous support of the College, the i-4 Center for Interdisciplinary Research has been established to create, nurture and promote culture of research and innovations. The College has approved more than 30 research projects under this scheme involving 30 faculty members and more than 150 students.

III. Infrastructure Development

- Smart internet Leased Line, an optical fiber based internet provides 24x7 internet facility and creates a modern and innovative ICT infrastructure in campus. Air-conditioned reading hall, touch screen information kiosks and facility for visually-impaired students improve the utilization of Library.
- A smart board is one brand of interactive whiteboard which allows to project an image and 'interact' with it by writing on it or moving it around. It is installed in Mathematics department. The SMART Board is connected to a computer and works with a projector.
- New Science Block building in reinforced concrete has recently been completed. It consists of three floors with highly equipped scientific labs and environment friendly big lecture halls. The floor system consists of a flat slab with two-way ribs and drop panels around the columns.
- A new conference room with facilities such as better sitting plan, web cameras, proper lighting and better ventilation is under construction.
- The college parking lot has been renovated. Old block of college campus is also under renovation.



Deshbandhu College Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) is a grievance redressal Committee constituted as a quasi-judicial body under the Parliamentary Act, Known as the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace Act (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal), 2013. Deshbandhu College has declared itself a zero tolerance zone for sexual harassment. The ICC ensures that it is followed in letter and spirit through various gender sensitization programs and learning activities in the college premises. However, due to concerns of the pandemic and following government directives, the ICC tried to carry forward awareness building through various programs and webinars online that are open to students, teaching and non-teaching staff in the college and beyond.

On July 15, 2020, ICC in collaboration with the POSHCA (NGO empaneled by the Ministry of Women and Child Development) organized a webinar, 'Gender Sensitivity: Best Practices to Follow'. addressed by a distinguished panel of speakers including Prof. Priya Sepaha, founder of Law Colloquy, Ms Varsha Jain, Head-Legal, at HUL.

An NGO named Nahi Means No with its members including Ms. Sunanda Kashyap, Afsheen Kanwar, Aanchal Sethi and Sangeeta Anand stressed that a firm 'no' to any untoward and unsolicited overture would curtail crime against women by 80 percent.

An international webinar entitled, 'Women Empowerment: A World View' was organized by the ICC on September 4, 2020. This program was very well attended by participants from across India, and also from across the border. The eminent speakers included, Ms. Phuntshok Tshering Chodden, head, 'Bhutan Network for Empowering Women', Ms. Shuchita Sonalika, Director and Head, 'Confederation of Indian Industry', North America, based in Washington DC and Dr. Sunita Kishor, Director of 'Demographic Health Survey at ICF' at Maryland, USA.
